1 STATUS AND NATURE OF THE INSTITUTE

UNESCO Madanjeet Institute for South Asia Arts (the Institute) has been established at BNU with the aim of furthering the South Asian Foundation's cardinal objective of promoting regional cooperation by creating greater opportunities for interaction among artists, practitioners, teachers, students and writers from South Asian countries through an agreement between The South Asian Foundation (SAF) and The Beaconhouse National University (BNU) on 20 November 2014.

The SAF's programme of Madanjeet Singh Group Scholarships (for students from SAARC Countries) includes a certain number of fully paid scholarships (inicuding tuition fees, travel, board and lodging) awarded each year on the basis of gender equality to two students from each of the SAARC country.

1.1 The Institute faces certain issues in bringing the international students to Pakistan. As a result, the condition to award two scholarships to two students from each of the SAARC country on the basis of gender equality, has not been met by the Institute.
